
The British

- Break the colonies in half by getting between the No. & the So.
- Blockade the ports to prevent the flow of goods and supplies from an ally.
- "Divide and Conquer" → use the Loyalists.

The Northern Campaign [1775-1776]

- Colonial Leaders-Benedict Arnold & Richard Montgomery
- Goal-Retake Canada and drive the British out of the North
- Outcome- Montgomery killed and Arnold's men are driven up the Lawrence River, the opposite way he intended to leave
- Canada is left to Britain

Phase I: The Northern Campaign [1775-1776]



Phase II: NY & PA [1776-1778]

- Colonial Leader- George Washington
- British Leader-Gen. William Howe/Lord Cornwallis
- Goal-Patriots want to set up in NY city, British want to capture and Control NYC area
- Outcome-Howe destroys Washington, but heavy fog enables him to escape South to the Delaware River in Penn
- Nathan Hale- "I only regret I have but one life to lose for my country"

Washington Crossing the Delaware

- Washington was chased all fall though New Jersey and crossed Delaware river into Penn for winter
- December 25, 1776-Washington gambled and crossed the frozen Delaware
- Captured 1,000 surprised Hessians who were still celebrating Christmas at Trenton, NJ
- A few days later Washington won a smaller battle at Princeton, NJ
- Gave the Patriots a huge morale boost!
